

Other Family Trees – MARRIS of Barton upon Humber

First Generation

1. **Thomas Marris** was born in 1782/1783 in Brigg, Lincs. He died on 30 Aug 1864. He was buried on 2 Sep 1864 in St Peter, Barton on Humber, Lincs.

Thomas married **Ann**. Ann was born in 1790/1791 in Spital, Lincs. She was buried on 22 Dec 1873 in St Peter, Barton on Humber, Lincs.

This is one of a number of MARRIS trees that has not been connected into the main Marris pedigree published on www.marrisfamilyhistory.uk.

Who were this Thomas & Ann Marris? It is possible they were Thomas Marris & Ann Cartwright who married on 28 Dec 1812 at Wrawby, Lincs.

We do know that they had a son George Marris (b.1815) who married Frances Newton. The marriage entry in the Barton on Humber PRs described George Marris as "Hairdresser of Barton" and his father Thomas Marris as "Hostler".

The 1841 Census at North Side, Beck Hill, Barton on Humber, Lincs, shows:

The 1851 Census at Beck Hill, Barton on Humber, Lincs, shows:

Thomas Marris, Head, Mar, 68, Ostler, born Lincolnsh Brigg
Ann Marris, Wife, Mar, 60, born Lincolnsh Spittal

The 1861 Census at 15 Beck Hill, Barton on Humber, Lincs, shows:

Thomas Marris, Head, Mar, 77, Retired Ostler, born Lincolnshire Brigg
Ann Marris, Wife, Mar, 68, born Lincolnshire Spital

In 1861, another Marris couple (Charles & Ann Marris) were living at 17 Beck Hill - though no relationship has been established.

The NBI V3 shows both their burials at St Peter, Barton upon Humber, Lincs:

Thomas Marris buried on 2 Sep 1864, age 80

Ann Marris buried on 22 Dec 1873, age 82.

An Mi at St Peter's Church, Barton upon Humber, reads:

Thomas Marris, died 30 Aug 1864, age 80.

Thomas and Ann had the following children:

Second Generation

2. **George Marris** (Thomas) was born on 20 Dec 1815 in Gainsborough, Lincs. He was christened on 18 Jan 1816 in Gainsborough, Lincs. He died on 4 Feb 1881. He was buried on 7 Feb 1881 in St Peter, Barton on Humber, Lincs.

George married **Frances Newton** on 11 May 1838 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs. Frances was born in 1809/1810. She died on 4 Nov 1881. She was buried on 8 Nov 1881 in St Peter, Barton on Humber, Lincs.

As described above, the marriage entry in the Barton on Humber PRs described George Marris as "Hairdresser of Barton" and his father Thomas Marris as "Hostler". Frances Newton was a spinster of Barton, the daughter of John Newton.

The 1861 Census at Fleetgate Distr ???, Barton on Humber, Lincs (indexed on Ancestry as Morris) shows:

George Marris, Head, Mar, 45, Hair Dresser & Haberdasher, born Lincolns Gainsborough
Frances Marris, Wife, Mar, 51, born Lincolns Barton on Humber
Fanny Marris, Daur, Unm, 20, Shop Woman, born Lincolns Barton on Humber
. . . and one hairdresser apprentice and one servant

The 1871 Census at Fleetgate, Barton on Humber, Lincs, shows:

George Marris, Head, Mar, 55, Hairdresser, born Lincolnshire Gainsbro
Frances Marris, Wife, Mar, 61, born Lincolnshire Barton
Fanny Marris, Daur, Unm, 30, born Lincolnshire Barton

Ann Marris, Mother, W, 80, born Lincolnshire Spital
. . . and one Servant

The 1881 Census at Fleetgate, Barton on Humber, Lincs, shows:

Frances Marris, Head, Widow, 71, Annuitant, born Barton Lincolnshire
Fanny Marris, Daur, Unm, 39, Annuitant, born Barton Lincolnshire
. . . and one servant

The index of wills at Somerset House shows:

George Marris (Hairdresser & Perfumer) late of Barton-Upon-Humber, Lincs. d. 04 Feb 1881. £5,000.
To; Frances Marris (Widow, Relict & Sole Executrix).

and:

Frances Marris (Widow) late of Barton-Upon-Humber, Lincs. d. 04 Nov 1881. £4,694. To; Fanny
Marris (Daughter, Spinster & Sole Executrix) of Barton Upon Humber, Lincs.

George and Frances had the following children:

- 3 M i. **George Marris** was christened on 19 Feb 1839 in Barton Upon Humber,
Lincs. He was buried on 27 Sep 1839 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs.

The NBI V3 for Barton St Peter shows the burial of George Marris, infant, on 27
Sep 1839. One assumes it was this George.

- 4 F ii. **Fanny Marris** was born on 2 Apr 1841 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs.
She was christened on 2 Apr 1841 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs. She
died on 7 Apr 1886. She was buried on 10 Apr 1886 in Barton Upon
Humber, Lincs.

The 1881 Census at Fleetgate, Barton on Humber, Lincs, shows:

Frances Marris, Head, Widow, 71, Annuitant, born Barton Lincolnshire
Fanny Marris, Daur, Unm, 39, Annuitant, born Barton Lincolnshire
. . . and one servant

The index of wills at Somerset House shows:

Fanny Marris (Spinster) formerly of Barton upon Humber but late of 4 Sewerby Villas, Bridlington Quay, Yorks. d. 07 Apr 1886 at Barton Upon Humber, Lincs. £3,925. To; John William Kirwan (Jeweller, Executor) of 48 Frederick Street, Birmingham, Warks & William Burnett (Chemist, Executor) of 3 Alexandra Arcade, Hedon Rd,

- 5 M iii. **Henry Marris** was christened on 9 Apr 1841 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs.

Henry Marris has not been located in the Census, nor has his burial been located.

- 6 M iv. **Thomas Marris** was christened on 13 Sep 1842 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs. He was buried on 4 Jan 1868 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs.

The 1861 Census at 213 High Street, St Benedict, Lincoln, Lincs, shows a likely Thomas Marris in the household of Thomas Holoran, Hairdresser, as follows.

Thomas Morris (sic), Ap, 18, Hair-dresser's Ap., born Lincolnshire Burton (sic)

The NBI V3 for Barton on Humber, Lincs, shows the burial of Thomas Marris, age 25, on 4 Jan 1868.

- 7 M v. **John Marris** was christened on 8 Apr 1844 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs. He was buried on 15 Jun 1844 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs.

The Eastern County Herald (June 20, 1844) reported the death of John Marris as follows:

At Barton on Thursday last, the infant son of Mr Marris, hairdresser.

The NBI V3 for Barton St Peter shows the burial of John Marris, infant, on 15 Jun 1844.

- 8 F vi. **Emma Marris** was christened on 4 Aug 1845 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs. She was buried on 15 Dec 1846 in Barton Upon Humber, Lincs.

The NBI V3 for Barton St Peter shows the burial of Emma Marris, age 16m, on 15 Dec 1846.
