

# Other Family Trees – MARRIS of Goxhill

## First Generation

### 1. William Marris.

This is one of a number of MARRIS trees that has not been connected into the main Marris pedigree published on [www.marrisfamilyhistory.uk](http://www.marrisfamilyhistory.uk).

The descent of this tree from the Second Generation below (i.e. William Marris & Elizabeth née Jackling of Goxhill, Lincs), is sound. The parents of this William Marris (Jnr) were William & Sarah Marris who are at the start of this tree. Looking at the PRs for various nearby villages at the time, one finds the marriage of William Marris to Sarah Gooding on 19 August 1782 at Great Limber, Lincs. Although circumstantial, this couple are the most likely parents. They also had several other children in the 18 years after their marriage. More evidence is needed to cement the early parts of this tree.

William married **Sarah Gooding** on 19 Aug 1782 in Great Limber, Lincs.

They had the following children:

## Second Generation

3. **William Marris** (William) was born about 1786 in Wootton, Lincs. He was christened on 15 Mar 1787 in Wootton, Lincs. He died on 2 Mar 1870 in Goxhill, Lincs. He was buried on 5 Mar 1870 in Goxhill, Lincs.

William married **Elizabeth Jackling** on 2 Dec 1811 in Goxhill, Lincs. Elizabeth was born in 1790 in Appleby, Lincs. She was christened on 14 Nov 1790 in Appleby, Lincs. She died on 17 Oct 1877 in Goxhill, Lincs. She was buried on 20 Oct 1877 in Goxhill, Lincs.

Elizabeth Jackling was the daughter of William Jackling and Mary Smith. Witnesses at her wedding to William Marris were John ?, William Jackling, and George Stamp.

NOTE - Henry and Charles above are assumed to be the illegitimate children of Elizabeth Marris, aged 25 (above). Baptisms were found for these two with the mother named as Elizabeth Marris, a single woman.

Edward married **Charlotte Dean** on 11 Jul 1850 in Keelby, Lincs.

Charlotte was born about 1830 in Keelby, Lincs. She died on 15 Mar 1913 in Goxhill, Lincs.

At the time of the marriage, Edward Marris was of East Halton, Lincs. The marriage was witnessed by John Dean and Elizabeth Dean.

7. **Edward Marris** (William) was christened on 12 Jan 1800 in Killingholme, Lincs. He died on 20 Aug 1861 in Bleasby Moor, Legsby, Lincs. He was buried on 22 Aug 1861 in Middle Rasen Topholme, Lincs.

Edward married **Charlotte Wright** on 5 Jun 1834 in Normanby by Spital, Lincs.

Charlotte was born in 1810/1811 in Normanby, Lincs. She was buried on 27 Dec 1855 in Middle Rasen, Lincs.

It would appear that this Edward Marris married Charlotte Wright and had children. However, although some records show them as Marris, Parish records such as their marriage and her burial show them as Marrows, as do the Census records. After the death of Edward Marris (sic) in 1861, The National Probate Calendar shows that an Admon was granted to his son Joseph Marris (sic), described as a Yeoman of Toft, Lincs. Edward Marris (sic) was buried at St Peter's Church, Middle Rasen Topholme, Lincs on 22 Aug 1861, aged 61. The burial register described him as Edward Marris of Toft.

The children of Edward Marris and Charlotte Wright generally persisted with the Marrows spelling. Where that was so, I have used Marrows rather than Marris below.

The GRO indexes show the death of Joseph's brother Edward Marrows, aged 74 in Mar Qtr 1922 at Caistor Reg. District, Lincs

Lucy was born at Chapel Hill, Bonby, the daughter of William and Sarah Cambleton. Lucy was of Barton at the time of her marriage to William Marris. The marriage was witnessed by Samuel Dunwell and Joseph Jackling.

This family used both Marris and Marrows and, for that reason, it has been harder than usual to locate them in 19th Century records. Should any present day descendant be interested, I am sure much more could be discovered, given time.
