

Other Family Trees – MARRIS of Holton-le-Clay

First Generation

1. William Marris.

William married **Mary**.

This is one of a number of MARRIS trees that has not been connected into the main Marris pedigree published on www.marrisfamilyhistory.uk.

The first two generations rely on information from another Marris researcher who had access to the Holton-le-Clay PRs. I have not myself verified the information but, from Generation 3 (below) onwards have checked almost all of the original records relied upon.

The origins of the above William & Mary Marris have not been determined. The IGI does contain two Marris baptisms at Holton-le-Clay in the 1600s. Perhaps they are related in some way. The two IGI baptisms are:

Ursula, bapt Nov 1677 at Holton-le-Clay, daughter of Richard & Ann Marris

Rebecca, bapt 3 Dec 1682 at Holton-le-Clay, daughter of Richard & Ann Marris.

William and Mary had the following children:

- 2 M i. **William Marris** was christened on 12 Aug 1728 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.
 He was buried on 13 Dec 1728 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.
- + 3 M ii. **Richard Marris** was christened on 11 Jun 1731. He was buried on 25
 Jan 1786.

Second Generation

3. **Richard Marris** (William) was christened on 11 Jun 1731 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs. He was buried on 25 Jan 1786 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.

Richard married (1) **Elizabeth Paddison** on 3 May 1750 in Healing, Lincs. Elizabeth was buried on 18 Oct 1753 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.

As with Richard above, it is assumed that it is Elizabeth Paddison he first married. The marriage at Healing, Lincs, was found in the IGI, although I haven't myself checked the actual Healing PRs. The villages of Holton Le Clay and Healing are only 6.6 miles apart.

Another Marris researcher found the burial of Elizabeth Marris at Holton Le Clay but didn't provide me with a reference.

Richard and Elizabeth had the following children:

4 M i. **Richard Marris** was christened on 1 Feb 1753 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.
He was buried on 26 Mar 1753 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.

An LFHS marriage index gives the marriage of Richard Marris to Oxley in 1854. Another Marris researcher has her as Sarah Oxley and the marriage date as 14 Nov 1754.

Richard married (2) **Sarah Oxley** on 14 Nov 1754 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.

Richard and Sarah had the following children:

+ 5 M ii. **Richard Marris** was christened on 8 Mar 1753.

6 M iii. **William Marris** was christened on 28 May 1756 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.

The baptism was found in the IGI.

Third Generation

5. **Richard Marris** (Richard, William) was christened on 1 Feb 1753 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.

Richard married **Sarah Hooton** on 12 Jan 1772 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.

Richard and Sarah had the following children:

- + 7 M i. **Richard Marris** was born on 1 May 1772. He died on 15 Dec 1838.
- 8 F ii. **Anne Marris** was christened on 19 Oct 1775 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.
- 9 F iii. **Sarah Marris** was christened on 8 Feb 1778 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.
- + 10 M iv. **John Marris** was christened on 29 Oct 1780.

Fourth Generation

7. **Richard Marris** (Richard, Richard, William) was born on 1 May 1772. He was christened on 3 May 1772 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs. He died on 15 Dec 1838 in Grimsby, Lincs. He was buried on 19 Dec 1838 in Grimsby, Lincs.

Richard married **Ann Paddison** on 20 May 1798 in Waltham, Lincs. Ann was christened on 16 Feb 1774 in Waltham, Lincs.

A Paddison descendant tells me that Ann's parents were James Paddison and Mary Partridge, who married 8 Jun 1772 at Barnoldby le Beck. Mary died 9 Oct 1789, aged 38, and James remarried to Elizabeth Neale at Tetney on 21 Jun 1796.

The Marriage Banns in the Waltham PRs say that Richard Marris was of Grimsby and Ann Paddison of Waltham. Witnesses were James Paddison, Wm(?) Barker and Jo(?)/Jn(?) Marris

The Hull Advertiser (December 21, 1838 edition) included Richard's death as follows:

Richard Marris, aged 66.

Richard and Ann had the following children:

- + 11 M i. **James Marris** was christened on 4 Mar 1799. He was buried on 17 Oct 1853.

- 12 M ii. **Richard Marris** was christened on 1 Oct 1808 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

10. **John Marris** (Richard, Richard, William) was christened on 29 Oct 1780 in Holton-le-Clay, Lincs.

John married **Grace Paddison** on 7 Feb 1809 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs. Grace was born on 1 May 1786 in Waltham, Lincs. She was buried on 20 Apr 1864 in Holy Trinity, Hull, Yorks.

It is the baptism of Jane (below) which shows that John & Grace Marris of Chelsea and John & Grace Marris of Grimsby were the same couple. In the PRs for Grimsby St James, there is a note against the baptism of Jane which says "Prin. Res. Chelsea, Middlesex". The baptisms below are all from

Chelsea (St Luke) or Grimsby (St James) PRs. In the Chelsea PRs, John Marris's occupation is given as Coach Maker. In the Grimsby PRs, his occupation is unspecified.

Grace Marris was buried at Holy Trinity, Hull, Yorks on 20 Apr 1864. The burial entry described her as age 78 of Myton.

John and Grace had the following children:

- 14 F ii. **Jane Marris** was born on 11 Jan 1812 in Grimsby, Lincs. She was christened on 24 Jul 1812 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs.
- 15 F iii. **Harriet Marris** was born on 22 Nov 1813. She was christened on 9 Jan 1814 in St Luke, Chelsea, Mddx.
- + 16 M iv. **Alfred Marris** was born in 1816. He died in Sep 1881.
- 17 F v. **Maria Marris** was born on 30 Dec 1818 in Chelsea, Mddx. She was christened on 31 Oct 1828 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

The Grimsby St James Baptism Register records that Maria Marris was born at Chelsea 30 Dec 1818 and baptized here [i.e. St James's] on 31 Oct 1828.
- + 18 M vi. **John Marris** was born on 23 Jan 1821. He died on 17 Jan 1893.
- 19 F vii. **Sarah Ann Marris** was born on 15 Jan 1823 in Chelsea, Mddx. She was christened on 31 Oct 1828 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

The Grimsby St James Baptism Register records that Sarah Ann Marris was born at Chelsea 15 Jan 1823 and baptized here [i.e. St James's] on 31 Oct 1828.

Fifth Generation

11. **James Marris** (Richard, Richard, Richard, William) was christened on 4 Mar 1799 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs. He was buried on 17 Oct 1853 in St Mary & St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

The baptism and marriage of James Marris was found in the PRs for Grimsby St James. His burial appears in the National Burial Index as at Grimsby St Mary & St James. The NBI says that James was age 55 at the time of his burial. The NBI burial record fits well; however I have been unable to find a parish of Grimsby St Mary & St James. Perhaps the NBI indexers meant Grimsby St James.

James married **Syndonia Hewson** on 27 Jun 1826 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs. Syndonia was born in 1800/1801 in Alford, Lincs. She died on 17 Mar 1870. She was buried on 21 Mar 1870 in Doughty Road Cemetery, Grimsby, Lincs.

I have not identified the two Marris/Morris boarders in the above Census.

An MI at Doughty Road Cemetery, Grimsby, Lincs (Ref: LI/M35 & 45 at the SoG) shows:

Syndonia Sidonia (sic), relict of the late James Marris who died 17th March 187?, aged 69 years,

Also of Louisa, the beloved wife of Richard Marris who died 4th April 1871, aged 29 years,

Also Edward Hewson, who died 7th August 1868, aged 72 years.

The baptisms below were found in the Grimsby St James PRs.

James and Syndonia had the following children:

- 20 F i. **Ann Ludlam Marris** was christened on 17 Jun 1828 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs. She was buried on 14 Jun 1829 in St Mary & St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

One assumes that the following entry in the National Burial Index refers to Ann Ludlam Marris:

- + 21 M ii. **Stephen Wright Marris** was christened on 17 Jun 1828. He died in Mar 1890.

The Grimsby St James PRs show the burial of "J Marris" on 25 Aug 1831, age 1. This is assumed to be James Marris, especially as the parents later baptised another of their sons James.

- 23 F iv. **Sabina Ann Marris** was christened on 29 May 1832 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs. She was buried on 10 Oct 1851 in St Mary & St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

24 F v. **Emma Marris** was christened on 26 Nov 1833 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

The 1861 Census at 10 South Street, Louth, Lincs, shows:

I have not traced Emma's aunt, Sabina Wright - but she clearly brought the "Wright" middle name into the Marris side (i.e. Stephen Wright Marris) and perhaps the Christian name "Sabina" as well (i.e. Sabina Ann Marris).

25 M vi. **James Marris** was christened on 16 Nov 1836 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs. He was buried on 3 Jan 1838 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

The Grimsby St James PRs show the burial of James Marris on 3 Jan 1838, age 14 months.

26 F vii. **Susannah Marris** was born in 1838 in Grimsby, Lincs. She was christened on 14 Oct 1838 in St James, Grimsby, Lincs.

+ 27 M viii. **Richard Marris** was born in 1840.

13. **Albert Marris** (John, Richard, Richard, William) was born on 21 Feb 1810 in Chelsea, Mddx. He was christened on 9 Mar 1810 in St James, Clerkenwell, Mddx. He was buried on 9 Jan 1868 in Canwick Road Cemetery, Lincoln, Lincs.

Albert married **Sarah Monks** on 5 Jun 1831 in St James, Paddington, London. Sarah was born in 1810 in Binbrook, Lincs. She was christened on 20 Jun 1810 in Binbrook, Lincs. She was buried on 15 Aug 1860 in Louth, Lincs.

The IGI shows Sarah's baptism at Binbrook, Lincs, as follows:

38 F iii. **Harriett Marris** was born in Mar 1857 in Hull, Yorks.

Frederick married **Emily Cunningham** in Dec 1880 in Leeds Reg. Distr., Yorks. Emily was born in 1854/1855 in Leeds, Yorks. She died in Sep 1945 in Leeds Reg. Distr., Yorks. She was buried in 1945 in Beckett St Cemetery, Leeds, Yorks.

Free BMD shows the marriage of Fred Morris (sic) in Dec Qtr 1880 at Leeds Reg. District, to either Emily Cunningham or Mary Jane L Walder. Given the Census records below, it is reasonable to assume that this was the marriage of Frederick Marris to Emily Cunningham.
