

Other Family Trees – MARRIS of Irby upon Humber

First Generation

1. **Edward Marris** was born about 1763/1764. He was buried on 18 Feb 1827 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.

This is one of a number of MARRIS trees that has not been connected into the main Marris pedigree published on www.marrisfamilyhistory.uk.

Edward married **Ann Stephenson** on 12 May 1785 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs. Ann was born in 1759/1760. She was buried on 24 Jan 1824 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.

The Irby marriage registers give Edward's surname as Maros. The marriage entry described Ann as a spinster and that both Edward and Ann were of the Parish of Irby. The wedding witnesses were Wm Trut & John Poot (Pool?). The Irby burial register describes Edward as "of Irby, age 63". The various baptisms of their children at Irby give Edward's occupation as "Labourer" and the surname as Marris.

The NBI V3 shows the burial of Ann Marris at Irby on 24 Jan 1824, aged 64 (i.e. born ca. 1759 / 1760). This is assumed to be the Ann (nee Stephenson) who married Edward Maros.

Edward and Ann had the following children:

- + 5 M iv. **Edward Marris** was christened on 24 Feb 1794. He died in Jul 1867.
- 6 M v. **Peter Marris** was christened on 21 Aug 1796 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs. He was buried on 22 Sep 1796 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.

- 7 F vi. **Sarah Marris** was christened on 8 Jul 1797 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.
She was buried on 10 Jul 1797 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.
- + 8 M vii. **George Marris** was christened on 22 Jul 1798. He died on 1 Oct 1878.
- 9 M viii. **Thomas Marris** was christened on 15 May 1802 in Irby upon Humber,
Lincs. He was buried on 19 Oct 1802 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.
- 10 F ix. **Jane Marris** was christened on 27 Dec 1803 in Irby upon Humber,
Lincs.

Second Generation

2. **William Marris** (Edward) was christened on 24 Feb 1786 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.
He was buried on 12 Jan 1863 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.

William married **Ann Morvison** on 13 Feb 1810 in Irby, Lincs. Ann was born about 1788 in Bradley, Lincs. She was buried on 6 Aug 1865 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.

The Irby marriage register records the marriage of William to Ann Morvison. The entry says that William was of Irby and Ann of Swallow - both single, (they married by Banns). The marriage was witnessed by William Marris & William Trought.

Note: Who was the William Marris who witnessed this marriage?

The NBI V3 shows the likely burial of Ann (nee Morvison):

Ann Marris, buried at Irby on Humber, Lincs, on 6 Aug 1865, aged 77 (i.e. born ca. 1787 / 1788).

William and Ann had the following children:

- 16 M vi. **George Marris** was born in 1820 in Barnoldby-Le-Beck, Lincs. He was christened on 14 May 1820 in Barnoldby-Le-Beck, Lincs. He died in Sep 1893 in Caistor, Lincs. He was buried on 22 Aug 1893 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.

The 1871 and 1881 Censuses at Irby, Lincs, find George Marris in the household of his brother Solomon Marris and family. See Solomon Marris below for the actual entry.

The 1891 Census at Bigby, Lincs, finds George Marris as a Boarder in the household of Thomas Hodson (Farm Labourer) and family as follows:

- + 17 M vii. **James Marris** was born about 1824/1825. He died on 8 Nov 1889.
- + 18 M viii. **Robert Marris** was christened on 10 Mar 1827. He was buried on 25 Mar 1853.
- + 19 M ix. **Solomon Marris** was christened on 6 Apr 1829. He died on 12 Apr 1911.
- 20 F x. **Hannah Marris** was christened on 18 Feb 1831 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.

Hannah married **John Clarke** in Dec 1859 in Caistor Reg. Distr, Lincs.

The 1891 Census at Wybers, Aylesby, Lincs, finds Hannah Clark, nee Marris in the same household as her niece Ann E Marris. One assumes her late husband was John Clarke, with the marriage taking place in December Qtr 1859 in Caistor Registration District. The census entry reads as follows:

5. **Edward Marris** (Edward) was christened on 24 Feb 1794 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs. He died in Jul 1867 in Caistor, Lincs. He was buried in Jul 1867 in St Peter & St Paul, Caistor, Lincs.

Edward married **Elizabeth Selby** on 6 May 1824 in Caistor, Lincs. Elizabeth was born about 1801/1802 in Snitterby, Lincs. She died on 26 Jan 1883. She was buried in Grimsby, Lincs.

We know from the Census that Edward Marris married Elizabeth and that they lived at Caistor. I have assumed that she was Elizabeth Selby who married Edward Marris at Caistor on 6th May 1824. The couple's first two children were baptised at Caistor. The baptism of the third child, Elizabeth, has not been located. Perhaps she may be found in the Caistor PRs.

Elizabeth Marris, Mother, W, 68, born Linc Snitterby

The 1881 Census at ??? Buildings, ???ow Gate, Great Grimsby, finds ELizabeth Marris as a boarder as follows:

Elizabeth Marris, Boarder, Widow, 75, on the parish, born Lincoln Snitterby.

Although, not conclusive, this looks like the Elizabeth Marris buried at Ainslie Street Burial Ground, Grimsby, Lincs. The entry records her death on 26th January 1883, age 80 years.

Edward and Elizabeth had the following children:

8. **George Marris** (Edward) was christened on 22 Jul 1798 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs.
He died on 1 Oct 1878. He was buried on 4 Oct 1878 in Cemetery, Cleethorpes, Lincs.

George married **Mary Appleby** on 17 May 1820 in Irby upon Humber, Lincs. Mary was born in 1794/1795. She died before 1851.

The 1841 Census at Great Grimsby, Lincs, shows two relevant households, both at River Head:

Baptisms have been located for all the above children with the parents named as George and Mary Marris. It is reasonable to assume that they were all from the same family.

Edward Marris (age 26 above) was the son of William Marris & Ann Morvison. He was the above George Marris's nephew.

The 1851 Census at Dial Square, Grimsby, Lincs, shows:

Since the above Charlotte Marris was born in Caistor, she was probably the daughter of Edward Marris and Elizabeth Selby - but I have not found a trace of her birth or baptism.

was born 3 Jun 1852 at Cleethorpes, Lincs and married Tom Chapman on 6 Aug
1873 at Clee, Lincs. Daughter Betsy Osbourne married James Paddison (the uncle
of fellow researcher Peter Paddison).

John married **Mary Ann Oke** on 6 Sep 1835 in Riby, Lincs. Mary was born about 1813. She died on 22 Feb 1899 in Georgetown, New York, USA.

William married **Maria Cash** on 10 Jan 1836 in Ashly cum Fenby, Lincs. Maria was born about 1811 in Louth, Lincs. She died on 28 Jun 1893 in Barnoldby-Le-Beck, Lincs.

The 1861 Census at Pelham Terrace, Great Grimsby, Lincs, finds Emma Marris as a servant in the household of John Coalsworth (Merchant) and family as follows:

Sarah married **John Rowson** on 15 May 1871 in Louth, Lincs. John was born in 1838 in Kelstern, Lincs. He died in 1903 in Louth, Lincs.

+ 42 M v. **William Marris** was born in Sep 1850. He died on 4 May 1917.

13. **Edward Marris** (William, Edward) was born on 23 Dec 1813 in Bradley, Lincs. He died on 16 Apr 1890 in Grimsby, Lincs. He was buried on 19 Apr 1890 in Ainslie Street Burial Ground, Grimsby, Lincs.

In 1841, Edward Marris was in the household of his uncle George Marris and family at River Head, Great Grimsby, Lincs. See the 1841 Census for George Marris & Mary Appleby below.

Edward married **Elizabeth Triffitt** in Jun 1843 in Caistor Reg. Distr, Lincs. Elizabeth was born in 1820 in Grimsby, Lincs. She died on 7 Oct 1856 in Grimsby, Lincs.

The only likely marriage in the GRO indexes is that of Edward Marris to Elizabeth Triffitt in June Qtr 1843 in Caistor Reg. District. Grimsby was in that Reg. District so I have assumed this was the right marriage. One would need to see the marriage certificate to be sure.

The Rev. George Marris, the oldest minister in the Methodist Ministry, died at his home in London yesterday at the age of 98. He was born at Hull in 1854 and was trained for the Methodist Church at Richmond College, entering the ministry in 1878. A year later he went to China and did excellent missionary work there. His Chinese translations are still used. After four years' service his health broke down and he had to return to England. For the remainder of his ministry he served in town circuits, being much sought after as a good and eloquent preacher.

As an official of the Methodist Conference he was quite outstanding. He was known as a very wise counsellor in conference committees, and the genial courteous old man was very popular. He acted

as Convenor of Scrutineers at the Methodist Conference from 1905 to 1908. The confidence the Methodist Church had in him was evident when he was sent as her representative to the Oecumenical [sic] Conference held in Toronto in 1911. Of his three sons, two entered the ministry – the Rev. G. Stainton Marris, who reached the age of superannuation as well as his father, and the Rev. C. Cathay Marris.
