

# Other Family Trees – MARRIS of Keelby (3)

## First Generation

### 1. Richard Marris.

This is one of a number of MARRIS trees that has not been connected into the main Marris pedigree published on [www.marrisfamilyhistory.uk](http://www.marrisfamilyhistory.uk).

It is likely that Richard Marris was baptised at Keelby, Lincs, on 2 June 1765, the son of William Marris & Sarah née Sargent. If so, then this tree can be merged with the "Marris of Keelby(2)" tree.

This may also be the Richard Marris who was buried at Winterton, Lincs, on 6 Dec 1847. The Winterton PRs say he was "Age 82, of Winterton" (and thus born around). He appeared in the 1841 Census at Town Street, Winterton, Lincs, as follows:

Richard Marris, 75, Ag Lab, y  
Mary Marris, 70, y  
Ann Marris, 6, ?

Ann in the above Census was presumably Richard and Mary's grandchild who would have been the daughter of Ambrose Hall Marris.

Richard married **Mary Hall** on 31 May 1791 in Barnetby le Wold, Lincs. Mary was born in 1769/1770 in Kirmington, Lincs. She died on 18 Apr 1865 in Roxby, Lincs. She was buried on 21 Apr 1865 in Winterton, Lincs.

The IGI records the baptism of Mary Hall on 31 December 1769 at Kirmington, Lincs, the daughter of Ambrose & Mary Hall. This is presumed the same Mary Hall and it does introduce the name Ambrose into the family. Her age is close to that of Richard, if we accept his birth as 1765.

Mary's year of birth is supported by her age in the 1861 Census at Roxby Village, Roxby with Risby, Lincs:

The index of wills at Somerset House shows:

Mary Marris (Widow) late of Roxby, Lincs. d. 18 Apr 1865 at Roxby. £100. Admon. To; William Marris (Son, Farmer) of Scotton.

The Winterton PRs show the burial of Mary Marris of Roxby, age 95, on 21 Apr 1865.

Richard and Mary had the following children:

The day of the burial in the Keelby PRs was hard to read. It may have been 5.

- +     6 M     v. **William Marris** was christened on 29 Mar 1801.
- 7 F     vi. **Martha Marris** was christened on 26 Feb 1806 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. Martha married **Thomas Gunby** on 16 May 1827 in Winterton, Lincs.
- 8 M     vii. **John Marris** was christened on 29 May 1808 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. He was buried on 14 Dec 1808 in Keelby, Lincs.

The Keelby burial register described John as the infant son of Richard and Mary Marris.
- 9 F     viii. **Ann Marris** was christened on 20 Oct 1809 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.
- +     10 M    ix. **Thomas Marris** was christened on 17 Nov 1811. He died on 16 Oct 1884.

11 F     x. **Jane Marris** was christened on 1 Sep 1813 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.

## Second Generation

3. **Richard Marris** (Richard) was born about 1794 in Keelby, Lincs. He was christened on 13 Apr 1794 in Keelby, Lincs. He died on 23 Sep 1865 in Keelby, Lincs. He was buried on 26 Sep 1865 in Habrough, Lincs.

Richard married **Elizabeth (Betty) Neale** on 18 Feb 1823 in Habrough, Lincs. Elizabeth was born about 1803/1804 in Killinghome, Lincs. She died after 1871.

An MI at St Margaret Church, Habrough, Lincs reads:

In memory of Richard Marris who died 23rd September 1865, age 71.

Richard made his will on 18 October 1855 and it was proved at Lincoln on 27 November 1865. In the will, he described himself as a yeoman of Keelby. The estate, valued at under £200 was left entirely to his wife Elizabeth. The will was witnessed by Thos Freer, Solicitor of Brigg and ???, his clerk.

Richard and Elizabeth had the following children:

+ 12 M i. **John Marris** was born about 1823/1824.

5. **Ambrose Hall Marris** (Richard) was christened on 14 Apr 1799 in Keelby, Lincs. He died on 19 Nov 1846. He was buried on 21 Nov 1846 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.

Ambrose married **Diana Rattan** on 12 Jun 1820 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. Diana was born about 1803 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. She was christened on 28 Jun 1801 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. She died on 13 Feb 1882 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. She was buried on 16 Feb 1882 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.

Diana's baptism is from the IGI which shows the baptism of Dinah RATON on 28 June 1801, Hibaldstow, to John RATON & Elizabeth. The surnames RATAN, RATON, RATTAN, RATTON of Hibaldstow appear to be the same family, with Christian names Diana & Dinah being similarly interchangeable.

The Hibaldstow marriage register records the marriage of Ambrose Marris and Diana Rattan. They were both described as unmarried of Hibaldstow, and were married by Banns. The witnesses were Richard Marris & Elizabeth Marris

In the above, one assumes that Nirene(?) was in fact Dinah's daughter Eunice and that grand-daughter Emma, aged 1, was the daughter of Eunice.

As explained under Ambrose & Ann Philadelphia Marris (below), Sarah Ann Marris (Daur, 6) was most likely the daughter of Richard Marris and Ann Philadelphia Stamford. After Richard's early death, Ann Philadelphia (and daughter Sarah Ann) moved in with Richard's brother Ambrose Marris. Ambrose and Ann Philadelphia then went on to have numerous children of their own (see Ambrose & Ann Philadelphia Marris below).

There are a number of records that show the death and burial of Ambrose Marris. Whereas the Hibaldstow Burial Register, and his MI at Hibaldstow, gives his name simply as Ambrose Marris, the GRO death index gives it as Ambrose Hall Marris, as does a burial index assembled by the Lincs Family History Society and also the National Burial Index provided by the Church of the Latter Day Saints. Another Marris researcher has confirmed from the Death Certificate that he was Ambrose Hall Marris.

Ambrose Hall Marris died of typhus fever (not certified). The Death Certificate records his death on 19th November 1846. The death was registered by Mary KIRKBY on the same day. However, the grave at Hibaldstow gives a slightly earlier date of death, The inscription reads:

In loving memory of Ambrose Marris, who died 9 Novr 1846, age 49  
Diana, wife of above who died 13?(th) Feby 1882, age 82 years

The Death Certificate of Diana Marris shows that she died on 13 Feb 1882 at Hibaldstow, age 82yrs, the widow of Ambrose MARRIS. She died of cardiac disease, bronchitis. Her daughter Eunice HALL was present at death.

An MI at St Hibald, Hibaldstow, shows:

Ambrose and Diana had the following children:

- 13 F     i. **Elizabeth Marris** was christened on 10 Sep 1820 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. Elizabeth married **Frederick Day** on 13 Aug 1845 in Waddingham, Lincs.

The Waddingham PRs show the marriage as follows:

1845 Aug 13, Frederick Day, full age, Bachelor, Labourer of Nettleton and Elizabeth Marris, full age, Spinster of Waddingham (her father named as Ambrose Marris, Labourer). Witnesses: William Skaith and Mary Marris.

- 14 F     ii. **Mary Hall Marris** was christened on 20 Jul 1823 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. She died on 9 Jan 1887 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.

Mary married **William Skaith** on 13 Jun 1847 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.

The Hibaldstow marriage register records the marriage of Mary Marris to William Skaith. They are described as both Servants of Hibaldstow, married by Banns. The father of Mary is named as Ambrose Marris, and the witnesses were Thomas East & William East.

Mary's Death Certificate gives her date of death as 9 Jan 1887, Hibaldstow, age 65yrs, wife of William Skaith, Mitral obstruction, Anasarca. Son R. Skaith in attendance.

- 15 F     iii. **Damaris Marris** was christened on 30 Oct 1825 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.

Damaris married **Unknown** in Mar 1846 in Glanford Brigg Reg. Distr., Lincs.

FreBMD shows the marriage of Damaris Marris in March Qtr 1846. On the same marriage page were four possible grooms:

+ 16 F iv. **Eunice Marris** was christened on 21 Oct 1827. She died on 19 Dec 1914.

17 F v. **Ann Marris** was christened on 20 Dec 1829 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. She died on 12 Jan 1907 in Waddingham, Lincs. She was buried on 15 Jan 1907 in Waddingham, Lincs.

Ann married **John Page** on 27 Nov 1848 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. John was born in 1825 in Whelton, Lincs. He was christened on 26 Jun 1825 in Whelton, Lincs. He died on 7 Jun 1887 in Waddingham, Lincs. He was buried on 9 Jun 1887 in Waddingham, Lincs.

Another Marris researcher provided me with the above marriage and their children. They can be found in the following Census returns:

18 M vi. **Ambrose Hall Marris** was christened on 8 Jan 1832 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. He was buried on 20 Jan 1832 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.

The National Burial Index (Hibaldstow) describes him as "an infant of Hibaldstow".

19 F vii. **Jane Marris** was christened on 16 Jun 1833 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.



- + 20 M viii. **John Marris** was christened on 8 May 1836.
- + 21 M ix. **Richard Marris** was born on 1 Jul 1838. He was buried on 6 Oct 1867.
- + 22 F x. **Diana Marris** was born on 21 Aug 1840. She died on 3 Aug 1915.
- 23 F xi. **Caroline Marris** was born on 10 Jan 1843 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. She was christened on 22 Jan 1843 in Hibaldstow, Lincs.

It is probably this Caroline who appears in the 1861 Census at West End, Hibaldstow, Lincs, in the household of the Skelton family as follows:

6. **William Marris** (Richard) was christened on 29 Mar 1801 in Keelby, Lincs.

William married **Sarah Barker** on 3 Mar 1825 in Scotter, Lincs. Sarah was born about 1801 in Scotter, Lincs.

There is an IGI reference to a Sarah Barker, baptised 3 March 1801 to Thomas Barker and Frances, Scotter.

Who was Elizabeth Credland, the niece? Was she a daughter of William Marris's eldest sister Elizabeth? One would need to locate a Marris / Credland marriage to be sure.

So far, only two children of William Marris and Sarah Barker have been identified, i.e. Barker Marris and Charles Marris. There is a 15 year gap between the two baptisms and one wonders if there were other children in between.

William and Sarah had the following children:

- + 25 M i. **Barker Marris** was born about 1825/1826. He died on 2 Dec 1903.
- + 26 M ii. **Charles Marris** was born in Sep 1841. He died on 15 Feb 1924.

10. **Thomas Marris** (Richard) was christened on 17 Nov 1811 in Hibaldstow, Lincs. He died on 16 Oct 1884 in Scotter, Lincs. He was buried on 19 Oct 1884 in Scotter, Lincs.

Thomas married **Mary Hunt** on 7 Sep 1837 in Grayingham, Lincs. Mary was born about 1814/1815 in Barton upon Humber, Lincs. She died on 18 Apr 1879 in Scotter, Lincs. She was buried on 22 Apr 1879 in Scotter, Lincs.

According to the Marriage Certificate, Mary was the daughter of Edward HUNT. The certificate dated 7th Sept 1837 for the Parish Church Grayingham reads: Thomas Marris, of full age, Bachelor, Labourer of Grayingham, father Richard Marris, labourer, Mary Hunt, of full age, Spinster, maid servant of Grayingham, father Edward Hunt, roper. Witnesses Maria Clifton & Thomas Stephenson.

The Death Certificate for Thomas Marris, dated 16 Oct 1884, Scotter, describes him as 73yrs, farmer, Broncho-pneumonia. Henry Hudson present.

There are two MIs recorded for Scotter at the SoG (Ref: LI/M20):

Mary, wife of Thomas Marris, died 18th April 1879, aged 64.

Hannah, daughter of Thomas and Mary Marris, died 1st October 1845, aged 7.

The Wills Index at Somerset House shows:

Thomas Marris (Farmer) late of Scotter, Lincs. d. 16 Oct 1884. £460. To; Hunt Marris of Scotter, Lincs (Son, Butcher).

The Butchers' shop belonging to Thomas Marris and son was situated on Messingham Road, Scotter, and is now The Ivy Lodge Hotel, with Ice cream parlour to rear. ca. 2002.

Thomas and Mary had the following children:

- 27 F     i. **Hannah Marris** was born on 4 Jan 1839 in Gainsborough Reg. Distr., Lincs. She was christened on 3 Feb 1839 in Scotter, Lincs. She died on 1 Oct 1845 in Scotter, Lincs. She was buried on 3 Oct 1845 in Scotter, Lincs.

Hannah Marris was born at 5.35pm on Friday 4 January 1839 and died at 6.45pm on 1 October 1845 (Ref: Family diary in possession of another Marris researcher).

There are two MIs recorded for Scotter at the SoG (Ref: LI/M20):

Mary, wife of Thomas Marris, died 18th April 1879, aged 64.

Hannah, daughter of Thomas and Mary Marris, died 1st October 1845, aged 7.

- 28 F     ii. **Mary Marris** was born in Mar 1841 in Scotter, Lincs. She was christened on 21 Feb 1841 in Scotter, Lincs.

The Scotter PRs show two baptisms for Mary, daughter of Thomas & Mary Marris of Scotter. The first took place on 21 Feb 1841 and the second on 6 April 1851.

Since the first Mary survived into adulthood, married John Andrew and had children, one can only presume she was baptised twice. It seems unlikely that parents would give two different children the same Christian name.

Mary married **John Andrew** on 24 Aug 1863 in Scotter, Lincs. John was born in 1843 in Wrawby, Lincs.

The 1871 Census at 94 East of the River vil(?) France, Scotter, Lincs, shows:

Mary Andrew, Wife, Mar, 29, Labourer's wife, born Scotter Lincolnshire

+ 29 F iii. **Jane Marris** was born in Jun 1843.

+ 30 M iv. **Henry Marris** was born on 3 Aug 1845. He died on 15 Mar 1907.

31 M v. **George Marris** was born on 20 Sep 1848. He was christened on 15 Oct 1848 in Scotter, Lincs. He died on 13 Dec 1865 in Scotter, Lincs.

George Marris was born at 2.30am on Wednesday 20 September 1848 (Ref: Family diary).

I have assumed that this is the George Marris who was buried at St Peter's Church, Scotter, Lincs, on 13 Dec 1865, age 17.

32 F vi. **Hannah Marris** was born in 1851 in Scotter, Lincs.

Hannah married **William Jones** about 1875. William was born in 1848 in Canterbury, Kent.

+ 33 M vii. **Robert Marris** was christened on 27 Mar 1853. He died on 6 Oct 1930.

+ 34 M viii. **Hunt Marris** was born in 1855. He died on 24 Apr 1933.

I have not yet found a link between these two Marris branches in the male line.
