

Other Family Trees – MARRIS of Tealby

First Generation

1. Thomas Marrows.

Thomas married **Elizabeth** .

This is one of a number of MARRIS trees that has not been connected into the main Marris pedigree published on www.marrisfamilyhistory.uk.

The surname in the Tealby PRs was spelt MARROWS, but MARRIS thereafter. The family's origins before Tealby have not been determined.

This is part of a tree published in the 1952 edition of Burke's Landed Gentry under the heading "Marris of Clinton House". Although the family existed (as shown below), I have been unable to find the evidence that they descended from Charles Marris of Keelby (1723-1783/4) as suggested by Burke's.

I have been unable to trace the origins of the above Thomas Marris. We do know that Thomas and Elizabeth (maiden name unknown) had three children christened at Tealby during 1780-3.

Thomas and Elizabeth had the following children:

- 2 F i. **Sarah Marrows** was christened on 21 Jul 1780 in Tealby, Lincs. She was buried on 22 Feb 1781 in Tealby, Lincs.

Tealby Burial Register described her as "infant".

- + 3 M ii. **William Marris** was born in 1781/1782. He died on 19 Oct 1859.

- 4 F iii. **Mary Marrows** was christened on 15 Jun 1783 in Tealby, Lincs. She was buried on 21 Oct 1787 in Tealby, Lincs.

Tealby Burial Register described her as daughter of Thomas & Elizabeth Marrows.

Second Generation

3. **William Marris** (Thomas) was born in 1781/1782 in Tealby, Lincs. He died on 19 Oct 1859 in Winterton, Lincs. He was buried on 22 Oct 1859 in Winterton, Lincs.

He was baptised as MARROWS but spelt MARRIS thereafter.

The Winterton PRs described him as William Marris (sic) of Winterton, buried Oct 22nd, 1859, age 77. This gives his year of birth as 1781 or 1782, which is supported by his age in the 1851 Census (below).

William married (1) **Mary Ann Milnes** . Mary was born in 1785/1786. She was buried on 18 Jan 1820 in Winterton, Lincs.

Mary Ann Marris died just a few days after giving birth to her ninth child, and namesake, Mary Ann Marris.

The Winterton PRs record Mary Anne senior's burial as follows:

Mary Ann, Wife of Wm Marris, Innkeeper of Winterton, buried 18 Jan 1820, age 34.

The Hull Advertiser (January 29, 1820) ran the following brief death notice:

Wife of W. Marris of the Cross Keys Inn, Winterton.

William and Mary had the following children:

- 5 F i. **Mary Ann Marris** was born on 27 Oct 1805 in Winterton, Lincs. She was christened on 30 Oct 1805 in Winterton, Lincs. She died on 1 Dec 1805 in Winterton, Lincs.

The Winterton PRs record the birth, baptism and death of Mary Ann Marris. The death is recorded as follows:

Mary Ann Marris, Dr. of Wm. & Mary Ann, Shopkeeper, died 1 Dec 1805, Infant.

- 6 F ii. **Ann Marris** was born on 17 Nov 1806 in Winterton, Lincs. She was christened on 21 Nov 1806 in Winterton, Lincs. She died on 21 Feb 1819 in Winterton, Lincs.

The Winterton PRs give Ann Marris as age 12 at the time of her burial.

- 7 M iii. **John Marris** was born on 9 Aug 1808 in Winterton, Lincs. He was christened on 11 Aug 1808 in Winterton, Lincs. He died on 31 Mar 1837 in Winterton, Lincs. He was buried on 4 Apr 1837 in Winterton, Lincs.

The Winterton PRs describe John Marris as "Age 28, of Winterton" at the time of his burial.

The Hull Advertiser (April 14, 1837) published the following Death Notice:

On Friday, the 31st ult, after a lingering illness of upwards of two years, Mr John Marris, son of Mr Marris of the Cross Keys Inn, Winterton.

John Marris made his will (LCC Wills 1837/264) on 23 March 1837 and it was proved on 30 September 1837. He described himself as a Yeoman of Winterton. His will mentions his father William Marris, his mother in law Elizabeth Marris, his sisters Elizabeth Marris and Mary Ann Marris, his brother Thomas Marris, his friend William Norwood of Winterton and his friend Thomas Crut of Beverley in the county of York. The will was witnessed by Geo Maxted and Lucas M Bennett. The estate was worth less than £450.

- + 8 M iv. **Thomas Marris** was born on 8 Apr 1810. He died on 27 Sep 1883.

- 9 F v. **Sarah Marris** was born on 24 Oct 1812 in Winterton, Lincs. She was christened on 24 Oct 1812 in Winterton, Lincs. She was buried on 24 Sep 1817 in Winterton, Lincs.

The Winterton PRs described Sarah Marris as age 4 at the time of her burial.

- 10 M vi. **William Milnes Marris** was born on 2 Dec 1813 in Winterton, Lincs. He was christened on 4 Dec 1813 in Winterton, Lincs. He was buried on 20 Feb 1814 in Winterton, Lincs.

The Winterton PRs described William Milnes Marris as an infant at the time of his burial.

- 11 M vii. **Wright Marris** was born on 16 Jul 1815 in Winterton, Lincs. He was christened on 17 Jul 1815 in Winterton, Lincs. He was buried on 23 Aug 1815 in Winterton, Lincs.

The Winterton PRs named Wright's parents as William & Ann (sic) Marris at his baptism but William & Mary Ann Marris at his burial. There is little doubt about the baptism as the father's occupation is given as "of Winterton, Innkeeper".

- 12 M viii. **Robert Milnes Marris** was born on 23 Sep 1817 in Winterton, Lincs. He was christened on 26 Sep 1817 in Winterton, Lincs. He was buried on 18 May 1818 in Winterton, Lincs.

The Winterton PRs named Robert as Robert Miles (sic) Marris at his baptism (parents named as William & Mary Marris, of Winterton, Innkeeper). Robert is named as Robert Milnes (sic) Marris at his burial, with his parents this time named as William & Ann Marris.

- 13 F ix. **Mary Ann Marris** was born on 10 Jan 1820 in Winterton, Lincs. She was christened on 13 Jan 1820 in Winterton, Lincs.

Mary married **Robert George Hunt** in Sep 1845 in Newark upon Trent, Notts. Robert was born in 1816/1817 in Worksop, Notts.

The 1851 Census at Russell Street, Newark on Trent, Notts, shows:

William married (2) **Elizabeth Norwood** on 10 Feb 1821 in Winterton, Lincs. Elizabeth was born about 1793/1794 in Winterton, Lincs. She died on 29 Sep 1874 in Winterton, Lincs. She was buried on 2 Oct 1874 in Winterton, Lincs.

The Winterton Marriage Register shows that William Marris was a widower, Elizabeth Norwood single and were both of the Parish of Winterton. They married by licence with consent of parents. The marriage was witnessed by John Stephenson, James Norwood & Mary Ann Norwood.

William Marris, Farmer of Winterton, made his will on 3 December 1858 and it was proved on 26 April 1860. He names his wife Elizabeth Marris (Executrix), Thomas Marris (son), William Norwood (Late Brother in Law), Mary Ann Hunt (daughter), Robert Hunt (husband of Mary Ann), Elizabeth Marris (relationship unspecified), John Marris (late son), Tom Marris (grandson), Nicholas Stanshard(?) of Winterton, farmer, trustee and good friend.

8. **Thomas Marris** (William Marris, Thomas) was born on 8 Apr 1810 in Winterton, Lincs. He was christened on 10 Apr 1810 in Winterton, Lincs. He died on 27 Sep 1883 in Worksop Reg. Distr., Notts. He was buried on 29 Sep 1883 in Worksop, Notts.

Thomas married **Maria Heane** on 3 May 1833 in Worksop, Notts. Maria was born in 1810/1811 in Worksop, Notts. She died on 23 Jul 1884 in Worksop Reg. Distr., Notts. She was buried on 25 Jul 1884 in Worksop, Notts.

The marriage of Thomas Marris to Maria Heane is recorded in the 1952 edition of Burke's Landed Gentry (Marris of Clinton House). The IGI also records the marriage but as Morris, not Marris. Burke's also gives the deaths of Thomas and Maria as 27 Sept 1883 and 23 July 1884 respectively.

- 18 F iv. **Mary Elizabeth Marris** was born in Mar 1842 in Worksop, Notts. She was christened on 21 Jan 1842 in Worksop, Notts.

Mary married **Charles Frederick Sutton** in Jun 1864 in Worksop Reg. Distr., Lincs. Charles was born in 1840/1841 in Alford, Lincs.

Mary (or Maria) Elizabeth Marris may be the Maria E Marris who appears in the 1861 Census (indexed by Ancestry as Marus) in the household Thomas Dafty and family at Caunton, Notts, as follows:

The 1871 Census at 40 Carlton(?) Road, Worksop, Notts, shows that by 1871, Agnes E Marris, daughter of Thomas Marris & Mary nee Heane (see their entry above) was now Agnes E Davy. Her husband wasn't present, so one can't identify his full name. The place and date of the marriage have not been located.

Clara married **Arthur James** in Sep 1883 in Worksop Reg. Distr., Lincs. Arthur was born in 1858/1859 in Nottingham, Notts.

FreeBMD shows the marriage of Clara Jane Marris. On the same marriage page were William Hoyland and Arthur James. The latter is more likely due to the following Censuses.

The GRO index of deaths records the death of Charlotte Marris in September Qtr. 1914 but says the death was registered at Dorking, Surrey. However, one assumes that both indexes refer to the same Charlotte as they are consistent in her age at death.

Thomas and Charlotte had the following children:

- 23 M i. **Thomas (Tom) Marris** was born in Sep 1874 in Worksop, Notts. He was christened on 7 Oct 1874 in Worksop, Notts. He died on 13 Aug 1944 in Ludham, Norfolk. He was buried in St Catherine Church, Ludham, Norfolk.

The 1891 Census at St Nicholas College, Lancing, Sussex, shows Tom Marris as a pupil:

Marris Tom, Student, Single, 16, born Worksop Notts.

The "Worksop Guardian" newspaper dated 24 Jun 1898 reported:

Mr Tom Marris junr. of Clinton House Worksop was shot in both legs during a shooting accident whilst hunting for Jackdaws in The Birklands. As a consequence of his injuries his left leg was amputated from below the knee.

In the years following his accident, Tom Marris toured Africa and took part in three "Big Game" trips.

The 1911 Census shows Tom Marris at 12 Albert Street, Boston, Lincs, in the household of Blanche Perkins, a widowed school mistress, aged 31, as follows:
